## **Instructions for Applying for Crystal Todd Scholarship**

#### To be considered for this scholarship, a student must:

- Be recommended by someone at the respective institution. The recommending employee must complete the Crystal Todd Scholarship Recommendation Form to be included in the student application packet.
- Be a female undergraduate student who has completed a minimum of one semester (12 hours) at the respective institution.
- Have declared a major in one of the STEM programs at Talladega College.
- Have a cumulative and prior semester grade point average (GPA) of 2.7 or above.
- Complete the application in its entirety.
- Submit an essay of 250 words, and no more than 350 words, on the following topic: "How I would use my STEM degree to better my community."
- The essay must be typed, double-spaced, in Times New Roman (or similar), 12-point font, and include the student's name in a running header on all pages of the document.
- Submit the most recent official or unofficial academic transcript.


